


Top 25 toys that support development in children of ALL abilities Recommended by pediatric therapists



PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:



Once the Squigz take hold, it takes some effort to pull them apart. When Squigz POP in protest – kids are delighted and it improves their fine motor skills. Squigz are perfect for bath-time play, improving direction following, sorting, sequencing, and encouraging creativity.

SUPER SORTING PIE BY LEARNING RESOURCE

AGE RANGE: 3 years old and up | COST: \$22-\$35



PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

The Super Sorting Pie is a fruity pie that teaches early number skills and attributes using color and fruit shapes. Place the sorting cards into the bottom of the pan to provide visual cues that support student success. Top crust becomes a bowl to conveniently hold counters.
